

There is No Special Pay or Per Capita Distribution Payment set for June 15, 2023 this is a rumour posted online.

The Samson Cree Nation has NOT received the Breach of Trust (Federal Court Action No. T-2022-89) Settlement Payment from Canada yet. The current expected timeline is that Samson should be receiving the Payment sometime in July or August 2023.

Below are some FAQ. Hopefully can answer the questions nation members have.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is this legal claim (Federal Court Action No. T-2022-09) all about?

Samon One Nation's ("BCN2) reserve lands, including the Figeon Lake Reserve, contain large posts of oil and gas. Why did SCN members vote in a referendum?

Since SCN filed the Smach of Trust Claim in 1999, BCN has spert many years pursuing and advancing these claims both inside the courts and through direct negotiations. Chief and Council and Canada have been able to regotiate an agreement in principle table of the velocity claims in the Breach of Trust lawsuit. Before the agreement in principle could be finalized. Canada requires 5CN members to approve the agreement in principle This is done through a interaction. If 5CN pills 1 of the members that vote in the interaction vote (year', then Canada and SCN will inside the self-enert agreement and SCN will collect the settlement money. The referendum was held on November 15, 2022, and passed with 63% of 1032 voter tumout, 65% in taivout.

How much money is SCN going to get in this settlement?

If the agreement in principle is approved, SCN and Canada will finalize the settlement agreement and SCN will receive \$134 million to compensate SCN for the claims in the Deach of Trust leveut.

Out of the \$154 million, how much does SCN keep and what do the lawyers get?

SON will get 100% of the settlement money. No lawyers get a share of the settlement

Do the members get any money?

Chief and Council has stated that they intend to deltribute 20%, or \$25.8 million, directly to SCN members.

What will happen with the rest of the money SCN collects?

Chief and Council has stated that they intend to allocate the funds as follows, 20% of the sattement will be deposited one SCN trusts for Julian generations, 10% of the sattement will be used to pay ISCN datas, 30% of the sattement will be invested in SCN infrastructure; and, 10% of the sattement will fund improved ISCN programs and services. This is subject to change based on Chief and Council.

When do the members get their distribution of the settlement money?

SC/L will collect the settlement money after all the other steps that Canada insists on are completed. This process can take a few months.

Have the members already received any of their distribution of the settlement money?

Yes, the SCN Chief and Council box out a loan to provide \$1000.00 to the nation member. the money vias distributed \$500 in December 2022, and \$500 in January 2023. This will need to be paid back to the financial institution it was loaned from with interval.

What else must be done?

Once the Settement Agreement is finalized, Canada has a condition that specific SCH taxsuits will be amended, that taxyon certificates must be prepared and signed, and that Chief and Council will peak resolutions and sign the Settement Agreement SCN will her ask the Federal Count to review the Sectement Agreement to make sure it as in the interests of SCN members. After this review, Canada will sign the Settement Agreement and transfer the settement money to SCN. Chief and Council and Canada are committed to completing this entire process by July or August 2023.

Has SCN gone to court on any of the issues raised in this lawsuit?

Has SCN collected any money from the Breach of Trust lawsuit?

Yes, as part of the mannanagement of SCNs royables, SCN and Canada setted one of the accounting issues and in September 2003, SCN collected \$15.5 million for this one error. This issues forced Canada to conduct extensive exutts of the royables part to SCN and repund Canada to begin to adjust the royables collected. Has SCN received any other settlement offers from Canada?

As part of the Breach of Trust lawsuit, SCN and Canada have tried to negotate a settlement of the lawsuit over many years. These negotations resulted in 6 formal watternest often from Canada. Did SCN give up any Treaty or Aboriginal rights and title in this settlement?

No. One fand Council are recommending this settervent because Canada has agreed to allow SCN to preserve and pursue to current Tready and Aborgenal rights and the claim agriest Canada and Aberts. SCN is only setting the contentine of and gas claims agrined Canada. Any rights (Theaty or Aborgenal) off-reserve will continue to be preserved. Canada has also agreed that if SCN wants to them SCN may continue to pursue any existing or future claims that it may have, on or off reserve, agrinal Aberts or individual of producers.

Did SCN give up any Reserve lands in this vole?

No, this settement does not involve the surrender of any SCN lands.

What was the Chevron lawsuit about and why is it important in this settlement?

Chevron, one of the oil and gas producers on our reserve lands, and Canada made errors and collected too much oil and gas royatises. Both Chevron and Canada sued SCH (No the setum of the royatise aven though SCH was not responsible and did not even involve there was an error. SCN, Chevron, and Canada went to the Aberta Court of Appeal on this issue and the Court of Appeal agreed that SCH was not detectly liable to Chevron or Canada for the matalase made by these two. After the Court of Appeal decision, Canada wanted to go back to Court and the set arear argument, that Canada should be allowed to pursue the otaim against the Keoniyaminaw Heritage Trust Fund. As part of this settlement, Canada has agreed to drop at \$7.0 million against SCN or the Kaoriyaminaw Heritage Trust Fund, regarding the Chevron everpartments.

Why are the Louis Bull and Montana Nation claims against Canada important in this settlement?

Royatties from Figeon Lake have been divided between the Maskwacis Nations based on population. Louis Bull and Montana have sued Canada and they argue that royatties should be spit in four equal shores. Canada have sued SCA and said that if Canada deshunded the royatties incorrectly then SCA's in responsible for Canada event. As pert of this settlement, Canada has agreed to drop its claim against SCN and has agreed that Canada will make whole SCN or the Kisonyammew Heritage Trust Fund if a claim is successfully made by ether Louis Bull or Montane Nations.

Was this the best deal SCN can negotiate?

A negativated settlement of a dispute between two parties is a compromise. Each side gives up something to eliminate the cost of going to court and to eliminate the risk of a negative judgment if they do go to court. Chief and Council believe this is the best offer that can be negativated without SCN spending a list more money on lawyers' fees and spending many more years pursuing at least some of these claims in mediation, the courts, or the Specific Claims process. It is possible that with more time and legal fees, more money out to also be that # SCN goes to mediation, the court, or Specific Claims a judge may not agree with SCN's position or may not agree that damages were suffered and SCN may receive less money or perhaps even no money. Because this agreement is principle does not compromise any of SCN's other Treaty and Aborginal rights and tible claims, Chief and Council is comfortable bringing this agreement in principle to the members of SCN.

Is this settlement the Cows and Plows?

No, this settlement is not the Treaty 6 Agriculture Benefits Settlement, aka Cows and Plows, that litigation is still in negotiations with Canada. This Settlement is the Federal Court Action No. T-2022-89, aka Breach of Trust Settlement.

In accordance with the Election Law section 20.3, and Schedule 8 section 6.5 (b)(iii) the Appeal Board orders a recount of all ballets under the following conditions:

- a) The recount shall be carried out by the Electoral Officer appointed by SCN BCR 2023-2024-774-8001 dated April 24, 2023;
- b) The recount shall be by tabulator on or before June 22, 2023, on Samon Cree Nation territory;
- c) The recount should include all ballots, including spoiled ballots;
- d) The Electoral Officer shall publish a Notice of the time and place of the recount at least 2 days in advance of the recount; and
- e) The recourt location shall be sufficient to allow scrutineers and SCN members to observe the proceedings.




June 12 & June 15, 2023
